*EARLY AND PERIODIC SCREENING, DIAGNOSTIC AND TREATMENT (EPSDT)***

El Programa de EPSDT (*Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment*, (por sus siglas en inglés) va dirigido a proveerle servicios preventivos, diagnósticos y tratamiento temprano a todos los beneficiarios menores de 21 años, participantes del Plan Vital. El objetivo principal de este programa es detectar de forma preventiva condiciones de salud en la población pediátrica brindándoles el tratamiento necesario. EPSDT ofrece cuatro tipos de exámenes: Médico, Visión, Audición y Dental. Estos exámenes están programados para satisfacer las actuales prácticas pediátricas y de adolescentes, y prácticas dentales para que los beneficiarios reciban servicios necesarios y así mantener su salud en óptimas condiciones.

En Plan de Salud Menonita (PSM) estamos comprometidos con nuestros proveedores en ofrecerles las herramientas necesarias para apoyarlos en el cumplimiento con el programa de EPSDT y con un servicio preventivo de calidad a los beneficiarios del Plan Vital. Para cumplir con este objetivo hemos desarrollado una planilla con los códigos CPT y ICD-10 que deben ser utilizados al proveer un servicio preventivo y/o de seguimiento médico según las guías de práctica clínica y de EPSDT. El utilizar estos códigos de CPT y ICD-10 correctamente, garantiza que su trabajo es documentado de forma apropiada para ser sometido a las agencias reguladoras (ASES) y al Programa de Medicaid.

Agradecemos su compromiso con la salud de los beneficiarios de PSM bajo el Plan Vital. De necesitar información adicional y orientación referente a los Servicios Preventivos Pediátricos y el cumplimiento con EPSDT.
